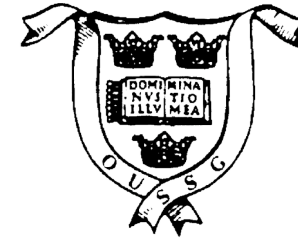
Membership Details
